**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE FOR THE  
AFRO-AMERICAN CULTURAL CENTER.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of Charlotte the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to be allocated to the Afro-American Cultural Center to study and assess the future of the center, prepare a concept design to define the various functions, needs, size, and other special requirements for each space within the proposed new building, and to study the feasibility of the community's readiness for a capital campaign to expand the center.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
