A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE FOR THE 3 AFRO-AMERICAN CULTURAL CENTER.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of 6 Charlotte the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal 7 year to be allocated to the Afro-American Cultural Center to study and assess the future 8 of the center, prepare a concept design to define the various functions, needs, size, and 9 other special requirements for each space within the proposed new building, and to study 10 the feasibility of the community's readiness for a capital campaign to expand the center. 11 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
