A HOUSE RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE DISABLED VETERANS WOMEN'S AUXILIARY STATE DEPARTMENT OF NORTH CAROLINA ON ITS FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY.

Whereas, in 1949, the Disabled American Veterans Women's Auxiliary State Department of North Carolina was formed; and

Whereas, for 50 years, the Disabled American Veterans Women's Auxiliary State Department of North Carolina has provided services to veterans and their families in the State; and
