1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE DISABLED VETERANS WOMEN'S
2 AUXILIARY STATE DEPARTMENT OF NORTH CAROLINA ON ITS FIFTIETH
3 ANNIVERSARY.

4 Whereas, in 1922 a national organization known as the Disabled American
5 Veterans (DAV) Auxiliary was formed to help protect the rights and benefits of disabled
6 veterans and their families; and

7 Whereas, any woman who is related to a disabled veteran may become a
8 member of the DAV Auxiliary; and

9 Whereas, the DAV Auxiliary is involved in a number of programs, including
10 visiting disabled veterans in hospitals and nursing homes, monitoring legislation that
11 affects the benefits of disabled veterans, providing various community service programs
12 for disabled veterans and educational assistance to the children of certain Auxiliary
13 members, and promoting programs that encourage good citizenship and patriotism; and

14 Whereas, in 1949, the Disabled American Veterans Women's Auxiliary State
15 Department of North Carolina was formed; and

16 Whereas, for 50 years, the Disabled American Veterans Women's Auxiliary
17 State Department of North Carolina has provided services to veterans and their families
18 in the State; and

1 Whereas, the Disabled American Veterans Women's Auxiliary State
2 Department of North Carolina will be celebrating its fiftieth anniversary on June 4-6,
3 1999, at its convention in the City of Fayetteville; Now, therefore,

4 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

5 Section 1. The House of Representatives wishes to recognize the Disabled
6 American Veterans Women's Auxiliary State Department of North Carolina for its
7 commitment to disabled veterans and to congratulate the Auxiliary on its fiftieth
8 anniversary.

9 Section 2. The Principal Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution
10 to Elizabeth Overcash, Commander of the Disabled American Veterans Women's
11 Auxiliary State Department of North Carolina.

12 Section 3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
