A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE OFFICE OF MINORITY HEALTH
IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Minority Health, the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to support the activities of the Office of Minority Health, which include, but are not limited to:

- (1) Providing training to reduce access barriers.
- (2) Developing minority-focused health status/health assessment reports.
- (3) Providing consultation and technical assistance and developing partnerships to address health disparity issues.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
