5	Section 1. Section 3 of S.L. 1997-337, as amended by Section 55.2B of S.L.
6	1997-456, reads as rewritten:
7	"Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law, expires 1 July 2000, July 1,
8	2002, and applies to permits granted and applications submitted prior to 1 July 2000. July
9	1, 2002. Any permits granted or applications issued prior to July 1, 2000 July 1, 2002,
10	shall be transferable."
11	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
