A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE SUNSET ON THE LAW GOVERNING PERMITS FOR
URBAN WATERFRONT DEVELOPMENT IN HISTORICALLY URBAN AREAS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 3 of S.L. 1997-337, as amended by Section 55.2B of S.L.
1997-456, reads as rewritten:

"Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law, expires ~~1 July 2000~~, July 1,
2002, and applies to permits granted and applications submitted prior to ~~1 July 2000~~. July
1, 2002. Any permits granted or applications issued prior to ~~July 1, 2000~~ July 1, 2002,
shall be transferable."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
