A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONTROL AND ERADICATION OF JOHNE'S DISEASE IN CERTAIN ANIMALS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of

Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of eight hundred seventy-one thousand one

hundred five dollars (\$871,105) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for the control and

eradication of Johne's disease in cattle, sheep, and goats.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
