2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE LUMBEE TRIBE SELF-
3	DETERMINATION COMMISSION.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
6	Administration the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2000-2001
7	fiscal year to partially fund the activities of the Lumbee Tribe Self-Determination
8	Commission, which was established by Superior Court Judge Howard E. Manning to
9	resolve the issue of determining the legitimate government of the Lumbee people as a
10	result of the Lumbee Tribe v. Lumbee Regional Development Association (LRDA)
11	lawsuit. The funds will be used to assist the Commission in:
12	(1) Determining whether the Lumbee people desire a tribal government;
13	(2) If so, determining the type of government they favor; and
14	(3) Preparing for and conducting any elections necessary as a result of that
15	determination.
16	Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
