4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
5	Section 1. G.S. 20-81.12(b2) reads as rewritten:		
6	"(b2) State Attraction Plates. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications		
7	for a State attraction plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer		
8	quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from		
9	the sale of State attraction plates to the organizations named below in proportion to the		
10	number of State attraction plates sold representing that organization:		
11	(1)	Friends of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park The revenue	
12		derived from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the	
13		Friends of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, Inc., to be used	
14		for educational materials, preservation programs, capital improvements	
15		for the portion of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park that is	
16		located in North Carolina, and operating expenses of the Great Smoky	
17		Mountains National Park.	
18	(1a)	The North Carolina Arboretum. – The revenue derived from the special	
19		plate shall be transferred quarterly to The North Carolina Arboretum	
20		Society and used to help the Society obtain grants for the North

2		Arboretum.
3	<u>(1b)</u>	The North Carolina Maritime Museum The revenue derived from the
4		special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the Department of Cultural
5		Resources, Division of Archives and History, to be used for educational
6		programs and conservation programs and for operating expenses of the
7		North Carolina Maritime Museum.
8	(2)	The North Carolina Zoological Society. – The revenue derived from the
9		special plate shall be transferred quarterly to The North Carolina
10		Zoological Society, Incorporated, to be used for educational programs
11		and conservation programs at the North Carolina Zoo at Asheboro and
12		for operating expenses of the North Carolina Zoo at Asheboro."
13	Sectio	on 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
