The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 7 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of forty-six million dollars (\$46,000,000) for the 8 2000-2001 fiscal year. These funds shall be used as follows: 9 \$8,400,000 to restore recent cuts in funding for the Thomas S. and 10 (1) 11 Willie M. programs; 12 (2) disabilities, and substance abuse services since 1992; and 13 14 (3) community mental health system. 15

- \$21,600,000 to provide inflationary increases for vital services in the
