A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE GRANTS FOR MEMBERS OF THE NORTH CAROLINA NATIONAL GUARD.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 127A-193 reads as rewritten:

"§ 127A-193. **Benefit.**

The benefit provided under this Article shall consist of a monetary educational assistance grant not to exceed ~~one two~~ two thousand dollars ~~(\$1,000)-(\$2,000)~~ per academic year to qualifying members of the North Carolina national guard. Benefits shall be payable for a period of one academic year at a time, renewable at the option of the Secretary for a maximum of ~~four eight~~ eight thousand dollars ~~(\$4,000)-(\$8,000).~~"

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
