A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE THE MINIMUM PAY OF  
SCHOOL SUPERVISORS, COORDINATORS, AND DIRECTORS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 8.15 of S.L. 1999-237 or any other provision of law, a supervisor, coordinator, or director assigned to the central offices of a local school administrative unit shall be paid at least as much as a public school principal classified as a "Principal III" with the same level of experience.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units, Allotment for Central Office Administration, the sum of two million one hundred sixty thousand nine hundred seventy-two dollars (\$2,160,972) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to implement this act.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
