4	UNIVERSITY SYSTEM AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THAT STUDY.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. The Board of Governors shall study the administrative system of
7	The University of North Carolina and shall study the educational priorities, construction
8	priorities, goals, and missions of each of its constituent institutions and how those relate
9	to the Board's vision and policies for the entire university system.
10	(1) The selection and approval process for the Board of Governors.
11	(2) Anticipated future methods of equitably funding The University of
12	North Carolina.
13	(3) Current methods of funding maintenance and repairs needed by The
14	University of North Carolina and how to provide future funding on a
15	permanent basis for maintenance and repairs.
16	(4) Current methods of funding new construction requested by The
17	University of North Carolina and how to provide future funding on a
18	more timely and equitable basis for all of the constituent institutions of
19	The University of North Carolina.

9	Section 2. The Board of Governors shall make an interim report regarding its
10	findings and recommendations to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental
11	Operations by November 1, 2000, and shall make a final report that includes the Board's
12	findings and recommendations to the 2001 General Assembly.
13	Section 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
14	Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of fifteen thousand dollars
15	(\$15,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for the study authorized by this act.
16	Section 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
