A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE DIVISION OF NORTH CAROLINA AQUARIUMS TO
2 DISPOSE OF EXHIBITS FROM THE COLLECTIONS OF THE NORTH
3 CAROLINA AQUARIUMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH GENERALLY ACCEPTED
4 PRACTICES FOR ACCREDITED ZOOS AND AQUARIUMS, TO REQUIRE
5 THAT THE NET PROCEEDS OF ANY SALE OR LEASE OF EXHIBITS BE
6 CREDITED TO THE NORTH CAROLINA AQUARIUMS FUND, AND TO
7 REQUIRE THE DIVISION OF NORTH CAROLINA AQUARIUMS TO REPORT
8 ON RECEIPTS OF AND EXPENDITURES FROM THE NORTH CAROLINA
9 AQUARIUMS FUND.
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11 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

12 Section 1. G.S. 143B-289.41(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
13 read:

14 "(1c) Notwithstanding Article 3A of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes, and
15 G.S. 143-49(4), dispose of any exhibit, exhibit component, or object
16 from the collections of the North Carolina Aquariums by sale, lease, or
17 trade. A sale, lease, or trade under this subdivision shall be conducted
18 in accordance with generally accepted practices for zoos and aquariums

1 that are accredited by the American Association of Zoos and
2 Aquariums. After deducting the expenses attributable to the sale or
3 lease, the net proceeds of any sale or lease shall be credited to the North
4 Carolina Aquariums Fund."

5 Section 2. G.S. 143B-289.44 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

6 "(d) The Division of North Carolina Aquariums shall submit to the Joint Legislative
7 Commission on Governmental Operations, the House and Senate Appropriations
8 Subcommittees on Natural and Economic Resources, and the Fiscal Research Division by
9 September 30 of each year a report on the North Carolina Aquariums Fund that shall
10 include the source and amounts of all funds credited to the Fund and the purpose and
11 amount of all expenditures from the Fund during the prior fiscal year."

12 Section 3. The first report required by G.S. 143B-289.44(d), as enacted by
13 Section 2 of this act, shall be due on September 30, 2000.

14 Section 4. Sections 1 and 4 of this act are effective when this act becomes law.
15 Sections 2 and 3 of this act become effective July 1, 1999.
