A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES FOR THE CENTER FOR ENVIRONMENTAL FARMING SYSTEMS AT THE CHERRY FARM UNIT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of one million nine hundred seventy-two thousand eight hundred sixty-two dollars (\$1,972,862) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of two million one hundred sixty-five thousand nine hundred sixty-two dollars (\$2,165,962) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to establish and support positions and for operating costs for the Center for Environmental Farming Systems at the Cherry Farm Unit near Goldsboro.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
