A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE GYPSY MOTH CONTROL PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of seven hundred thirty-nine thousand five hundred ninety-three dollars (\$739,593) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of seven hundred twenty-six thousand four hundred twenty-four dollars (\$726,424) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to establish and support positions and for the operating costs of the Department's program to control the gypsy moth.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
