2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR STAFF AND FOR THE COSTS OF
3	OPERATING THE RESEARCH STATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
4	AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES LOCATED IN OXFORD.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
7	Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of two hundred twenty-nine thousand two
8	hundred four dollars (\$229,204) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of two
9	hundred twelve thousand two hundred four dollars (\$212,204) for the 2000-2001 fiscal
0	year to establish and support positions to maintain, and for the costs to operate, the
1	Department's research station located in the Moss Building in Oxford, which building
2	was formerly occupied by the United States Department of Agriculture.
13	Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
