**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR STAFF AND FOR THE COSTS OF  
OPERATING THE RESEARCH STATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF  
AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES LOCATED IN OXFORD.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of two hundred twenty-nine thousand two hundred four dollars (\$229,204) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred twelve thousand two hundred four dollars (\$212,204) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to establish and support positions to maintain, and for the costs to operate, the Department's research station located in the Moss Building in Oxford, which building was formerly occupied by the United States Department of Agriculture.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
