A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE SALARIES FOR SCHOOL
CENTRAL OFFICE PERSONNEL AND FOR NONCERTIFIED SCHOOL
PERSONNEL.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1.(a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of three million three hundred forty-seven thousand nineteen dollars (\$3,347,019) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of three million three hundred forty-seven thousand nineteen dollars (\$3,347,019) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to increase the salaries of school central office personnel including superintendents, assistant superintendents, associate superintendents, directors/coordinators, supervisors, and finance officers, by three percent (3%) for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999.

Section 1.(b) There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of five hundred fifty-seven thousand eight hundred thirty-six dollars (\$557,836) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred fifty-seven thousand eight hundred thirty-six dollars (\$557,836) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to provide a one-half percent (1/2%) bonus to school central office personnel including superintendents, assistant superintendents, associate superintendents, directors/coordinators, supervisors, and finance officers, by one-half percent (1/2%) for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999.

Section 2.(a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of twenty-two million five hundred eight thousand five hundred forty-one dollars (\$22,508,541) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of twenty-two million five hundred eight thousand five hundred forty-one dollars (\$22,508,541) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to increase the salaries of all noncertified public school employees whose salaries are supported from the State's General Fund by three percent (3%), for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1999.

Section 2.(b) There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of three million seven hundred fifty-one thousand four hundred twenty-four dollars (\$3,751,424) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of three million seven hundred fifty-one thousand four hundred twenty-four dollars (\$3,751,424) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to provide a one-half percent (1/2%) bonus to all noncertified public school employees whose salaries are supported from the State's General Fund by three percent (3%), for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1999.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
