Section 1. The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall study the effectiveness of providing adult education, literacy, and high school equivalency programs through the North Carolina Community College System. In the course of its study, the Committee shall consider coordination of community college programs and program requirements with those of the public schools, whether the resources of the public school system could and should be better utilized in providing these programs, and other matters the Committee deems appropriate.

The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee may make an interim report on this subject to the 1999 General Assembly, 2000 Regular Session, and shall make a final report to the 2001 General Assembly.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
