A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CRAVEN COUNTY TO ACQUIRE REAL PROPERTY  
BY CONDEMNATION FOR CONVENTION CENTER PURPOSES AND TO  
ACQUIRE THE FEE OR ANY LESSER INTEREST.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 40A-3(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Local Public Condemnors. – For the public use or benefit, the governing body of each municipality or county shall possess the power of eminent domain and may acquire by purchase, gift or condemnation any property, either inside or outside its boundaries, for the following purposes.

...

(10) Establishing, enlarging, or improving publicly owned convention center facilities. The fee or any lesser interest may be condemned for the purpose contained in this subdivision.

The board of education of any municipality or county or a combined board may exercise the power of eminent domain under this Chapter for purposes authorized by other statutes.

The power of eminent domain shall be exercised by local public condemnors under the procedures of Article 3 of this Chapter."

- 1           Section 2. This act applies to the County of Craven.
- 2           Section 3. This act expires November 16, 2002.
- 3           Section 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
