A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A HOME- AND
2 COMMUNITY-BASED MEDICAID WAIVER FOR PERSONS WITH
3 TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
7 Health and Human Services the sum of one million five hundred one thousand three
8 hundred three dollars (\$1,501,303) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of one
9 million five hundred one thousand three hundred three dollars (\$1,501,303) for the 2000-
10 2001 fiscal year to be used as State matching funds to support a Home- and Community-
11 Based Medicaid Waiver for approximately 100 individuals with Traumatic Brain Injury
12 at a per diem cost of one hundred sixteen dollars and two cents (\$116.02) per person and
13 to be used for administrative support to manage the waiver.

14 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
