A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A HOME- AND COMMUNITY-BASED MEDICAID WAIVER FOR PERSONS WITH TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of one million five hundred one thousand three hundred three dollars (\$1,501,303) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of one million five hundred one thousand three hundred three dollars (\$1,501,303) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to be used as State matching funds to support a Home- and Community-Based Medicaid Waiver for approximately 100 individuals with Traumatic Brain Injury at a per diem cost of one hundred sixteen dollars and two cents (\$116.02) per person and to be used for administrative support to manage the waiver.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
