A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A NEUROBEHAVIORAL 2 TREATMENT PROGRAM AT THE BLACK MOUNTAIN CENTER. 3 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of six hundred ninety-one thousand seven hundred 6 seventy-two dollars (\$691,772) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred 7 seventy-one thousand five hundred twenty-six dollars (\$571,526) for the fiscal year 2000-8 2001 to establish a 12-bed short-term Neurobehavioral Treatment Program at Black 9 Mountain Center for persons with Traumatic Brain Injury who have significant behavior 10 problems. 11

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
