2	AN ACT TO	PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
3	SHALL PAY	THE NONBETTERMENT COSTS OF UTILITY RELOCATIONS IN
4	CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.	
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
6	Section 1. G.S. 136-27.1 reads as rewritten:	
7	"§ 136-27.1. F	Relocation of water and sewer lines of municipalities and nonprofit
8	water	or sewer corporations or associations.
9	The Department of Transportation shall pay the nonbetterment cost for the relocation	
10	of water and sewer lines, located within the existing State highway right-of-way, that are	
11	necessary to be relocated for a State highway improvement project and that are owned by:	
12	any of the following:	
13	<u>(1)</u>	(i) a <u>Owned by a municipality</u> with a population of 5,500 or less
14		according to the latest decennial census; (ii) census.
15	<u>(2)</u>	a-Owned by a nonprofit water or sewer association or corporation; (iii)
16		corporation.
17	<u>(3)</u>	any Owned by any water or sewer system organized pursuant to Chapter
18		162A of the General Statutes; (iv) Statutes.
19	<u>(4)</u>	a-Owned by a rural water system operated by county as an enterprise
20		system; (v)-<u>system.</u>

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1	(5) any Owned by any sanitary district organized pursuant to Part 2 of
2	Article 2 of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes; or (vi)-Statutes.
3	(6) <u>constructed Constructed</u> by a water or sewer system organized pursuant
4	to Chapter 162A of the General Statutes and then sold or transferred to a
5	municipality with a population of greater than 5,500 according to the
6	latest decennial census.
7	(7) Owned by any municipality with a population of 20,000 or less
8	according to the latest decennial census when all of the following
9	conditions apply:
10	a. The line or lines were ordered to be installed by one State
11	agency, construction was started, and then the line or lines were
12	ordered to be relocated by the Department within four years in
13	connection with reconstruction of a federal primary highway.
14	b. The municipality operates its water or sewer system as an
15	enterprise system and has not used any of the proceeds from its
16	water or sewer enterprise fund for any purposes other than water
17	or sewer purposes during the previous five years."
18	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
