A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT EXPANDING THE PERMISSIBLE PURPOSES OF THE GREENVILLE UTILITIES COMMISSION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. In addition to the allowable public enterprises that the Greenville Utilities Commission may undertake pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 861 of the 1991 Session Laws, the Greenville Utilities Commission shall have the authority, with the approval of the City Council of the City of Greenville, to acquire, construct, establish, enlarge, improve, maintain, own, operate, or contract for the operation of the following:

- (1) Steam and chilled water supply and distribution systems.
- (2) Public enterprises of a public or private entity other than the City of Greenville that may lawfully be operated by a municipality if the enterprise is located within Pitt County.
- (3) Appliance warranty programs, security monitoring systems, and surge protection programs for customers of the Greenville Utilities Commission.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
