1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE PRINCIPAL SALARIES.
3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local
5	School Administrative Units the sum of twenty-two million dollars (\$22,000,000) for the
6	1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of twenty-two million dollars (\$22,000,000) for the
7	2000-2001 fiscal year to increase salaries of principals and assistant principals. These
8	funds shall be used to:
9	(1) Modify the school-administrator salary schedule consistent with
10	modifications in the teacher salary schedule,
11	(2) Provide a bonus if the employee's school met or exceeded the projected
12	levels of improvement in student performance for the prior school year,
13	in accordance with the ABCs of Public Education Program, and
14	(3) Provide a bonus if the employee's school met objectively measurable
15	goals set by the local board of education for maintaining a safe and
16	orderly school.
17	Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
