A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE STATE SCHOOL TECHNOLOGY FUND.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of forty-five million dollars (\$45,000,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of forty-five million dollars (\$45,000,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for the State School Technology Fund. Local boards of education may use funds allocated to them from the Fund to implement local school technology plans approved by the State Board of Education.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
