A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MAKE IT A CRIMINAL OFFENSE TO USE MIRRORS, VIDEO  
EQUIPMENT, AND OTHER MEANS TO SECRETLY VIEW ANOTHER  
PERSON'S BODY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 14-202 reads as rewritten:

**"§ 14-202. Secretly peeping into room occupied by ~~female~~ another person.**

Any person who shall peep secretly into any room occupied by a ~~female~~ another person, or who shall use any means by which secretly to view or attempt to view another person's body or any part of the person's body including mirrors or other reflective surfaces, video or other recording equipment, and the like, ~~shall be~~ is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor."

Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1999, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
