1 A SENATE RESOLUTION HONORING THE EARLY OFFICERS OF THE TOWN  
2 OF SHALLOTTE ON THE ONE HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE TOWN.  
3 Whereas, on March 6, 1999, the Town of Shallotte in Brunswick County will  
4 be celebrating 100 years of incorporation; and  
5 Whereas, the Town was named for the Shallotte River from which it is located;  
6 and  
7 Whereas, the Town's first temporary officers included George Leonard as  
8 mayor; James Holmes, Charles Hemmingway, W.A. Frink, R.V. Leonard, and F.P. White  
9 as commissioners; McD. Turner as marshall; and John W. Moore as treasurer; and  
10 Whereas, many of descendants of these first officers continue to live in the  
11 Town of Shallotte, the County of Brunswick, and surrounding areas; and  
12 Whereas, the Town's 100th anniversary and the contributions made by these  
13 early officers to the development of the Town are worthy of celebration and should be  
14 enjoyed and supported by all North Carolina citizens; Now, therefore,  
15 Be it resolved by the Senate:  
16 Section 1. The Senate honors the life and memory of the Town of Shallotte's  
17 first officers and urges the citizens of this State to participate in the activities  
18 commemorating the 100th anniversary of the Town of Shallotte.

- 1                   Section 2. The Principal Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution  
2 to the Mayor and the Town Manager of the Town of Shallotte.  
3                   Section 3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
