A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ENHANCE THE STATE'S PURCHASING PROGRAM AND THEREBY
REDUCE THE COST OF OBTAINING GOODS AND SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 143-49(6) reads as rewritten:

"§ 143-49. Powers and duties of Secretary.

The Secretary of Administration shall have power and authority, and it shall be his
duty, subject to the provisions of this Article:

...

(6)To make available to nonprofit corporations operating charitable hospitals, to local nonprofit com
licensed or approved by the Department of Health and Human Services as child placing
agencies, residential child-care facilities, private nonprofit rural, community, and migrant
health centers designated by the Office of Rural Health and Resource Development, to
private higher education institutions that are defined as "institutions" in G.S. 116-22(1),
and to counties, cities, towns, governmental entities and other subdivisions of the State
and public agencies thereof in the expenditure of public funds, the services of the
Department of Administration in the purchase of materials, supplies and equipment under
such rules, regulations and procedures as the Secretary of Administration may adopt. In
