Whereas, the City of Winston-Salem has set out to revitalize some of its lower income areas by developing an Airport Business Park; and Whereas, the Airport Business Park will be located near the Smith Reynolds Airport, US 52 and Norfolk Southern's rail lines, making it a desirable business location; and

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of Winston-Salem the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to assist with the development of the Airport Business Park.

Whereas, the City of Winston-Salem hopes to attract manufacturing, warehousing, and
