May 23, 2000 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VARIOUS PUBLIC OFFICES UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE. Whereas, G.S. 120-121 authorizes the General Assembly to make certain appointments to public offices upon the recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and Whereas, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate has made recommendations; Now, therefore. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Julia Bryan Jones Daniels of Wake County and Linda Godwin Murphy of Duplin County are appointed to the Board of Trustees of the North Carolina Museum of Art for terms expiring on June 30, 2001. Section 2. Unless otherwise specified, all appointments made by this act are for terms to begin July 1, 2000. Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
