1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CONVERT THREE TEMPORARY AVIATION POSITIONS WITHIN THE DIVISION OF FOREST RESOURCES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO PERMANENT POSITIONS AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT THIS CONVERSION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The two temporary pilot positions within the Division of Forest Resources of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources are converted to permanent positions.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Forest Resources, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, the sum of thirty-seven thousand six hundred sixty-six dollars (\$37,666) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to establish and support these permanent positions under Section 1 of this act, which sum represents the difference between the sum of eighty-nine thousand six hundred sixty-six dollars (\$89,666) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year, the total cost to establish and support two permanent pilot positions, and the sum of fifty-two thousand dollars (\$52,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year that was appropriated for these temporary positions in S.L. 1999-237, the Current Operations and Capital Improvements Appropriations Act of 1999.

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Section 3. The temporary position of aircraft mechanic within the Division of Forest Resources of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources is converted to a permanent position.

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Section 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Forest Resources, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, the sum of twenty thousand seven hundred ninety dollars (\$20,790) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to establish and support the permanent position under Section 3 of this act, which sum represents the difference between the sum of forty-four thousand five hundred two dollars (\$44,502) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year, the total cost to establish and support a permanent position of aircraft mechanic, and the sum of twenty-three thousand seven hundred twelve dollars (\$23,712) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year that was appropriated for these temporary positions in S.L. 1999-237, the Current Operations and Capital Improvements Appropriations Act of 1999.

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Section 5. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
