Short Title: Harriet's House Funds.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR HARRIET'S HOUSE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to support the programs at Harriet's House, a transitional home for female offenders and their children. Harriet's House shall report quarterly to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on the expenditure of State appropriations and on the effectiveness of the program, including information on the number of clients served and the number of clients who successfully complete the Harriet's House program.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
