May 30, 2000 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ISSUE SPECIAL PERMITS FOR THE TRANSIT OF MANUFACTURED HOUSING UP TO SIXTEEN FEET IN WIDTH AND PROVIDING FOR A PERMIT FEE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 20-119 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(c1) Notwithstanding subsection (c) of this section, the Department shall issue permits for the transit of manufactured housing up to 16 feet in width. The fee for a single-trip permit for the movement of manufactured housing over 14 feet and up to 16 feet in width shall be twelve dollars (\$12.00) for a single-trip permit and sixty dollars (\$60.00) for an annual permit." Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
