A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO RENOVATE AND RESTORE THE FIRE-DAMAGED MACON COUNTY HISTORICAL MUSEUM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Macon County Historical Society, Incorporated, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to renovate and restore the fire-damaged portion of the Macon County Historical Museum in the Town of Franklin. The restored area will provide space for collections, meetings, displays, and special events.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
