There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Fire Museum, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to assist in establishing an educational museum which will preserve and exhibit the history and artifacts of regional

fire departments. Museum staff will teach and promote fire safety and prevention, as
