February 4, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR HOUSING FOR ELDERLY PERSONS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Housing Finance Agency the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to provide affordable housing for elderly persons. Beginning with the 2001-2002 fiscal year, funding for housing for the elderly shall be included in the Housing Finance Agency's continuation budget request. Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
