A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE JUVENILE JUSTICE INSTITUTE AT NORTH
CAROLINA CENTRAL UNIVERSITY AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO
HELP SUPPORT THE INSTITUTE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. North Carolina Central University shall establish a juvenile justice institute on its campus. The juvenile justice institute shall have as its objectives the following:

- (1) To compile and disseminate information about State and national best practices in the field.
- (2) To serve as a resource to the academic community and provide practical experience about current programs and practice.
- (3) Upon request, to provide technical experience and training in generic program types for small, not-for-profit community groups.
- (4) To survey the public and special interest groups about juvenile justice program effectiveness.
- (5) To distribute a quarterly newsletter that continually informs those interested in juvenile justice issues.
- (6) To provide a training ground for Criminal Justice majors.

1 Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
2 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of five hundred thousand dollars
3 (\$500,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred thousand dollars
4 (\$500,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for North Carolina Central University to
5 establish a juvenile justice institute on its campus and to help support that institute.
6 Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
