6	Section 1. North Carolina Central University shall establish a juvenile justice	
7	institute on its	campus. The juvenile justice institute shall have as its objectives the

9	(1)	To compile and disseminate information about State and national best
10		practices in the field.
11	(2)	To serve as a resource to the academic community and provide practical
12		experience about current programs and practice.
13	(3)	Upon request, to provide technical experience and training in generic
14		program types for small, not-for-profit community groups.
15	(4)	To survey the public and special interest groups about juvenile justice
16		program effectiveness.
17	(5)	To distribute a quarterly newsletter that continually informs those
18		interested in juvenile justice issues.
19	(6)	To provide a training ground for Criminal Justice majors.

## **GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA**

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of 1 2 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of five hundred thousand dollars 3 (\$500,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for North Carolina Central University to 4 establish a juvenile justice institute on its campus and to help support that institute. 5 Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999. 6
