SENATE BILL 474

Short Title: Hendersonville ABC Profits.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO MODIFY THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE PROFITS FROM THE
2 HENDERSONVILLE LOCAL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL SYSTEM.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 Section 1. Section 6 of Chapter 954 of the 1955 Session Laws as amended by
5 Section 1 of Chapter 105 of the 1995 Session Laws reads as rewritten:

6 "Sec. 6. The net profits derived from the operation of a liquor control store in the City
7 of Hendersonville, after deducting the necessary funds for law enforcement as provided
8 in G.S. 18B-805(e)(2), G.S. 18B-805(c)(2) and after deducting the necessary funds for
9 treatment of alcoholism or substance abuse or for research or education on alcoholism or
10 substance abuse as provided in G.S. 18B-805(c)(3), shall be divided as follows: Fifty per
11 cent (50%) for municipality of Hendersonville. Twenty-five per cent (25%) to
12 Governing Body of the County of Henderson. One per cent (1%) to the City Library.
13 Twenty-four per cent (24%) to the Henderson County Public Schools. Such funds shall
14 be subject to appropriation by the Governing Bodies of the City of Hendersonville and
15 the County of Henderson for any lawful purpose."

16 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
