**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS OF  
THE CALDWELL COUNTY HERITAGE MUSEUM'S FACILITY AND  
HISTORICAL DISPLAYS.**

Whereas, the Caldwell County Heritage Museum is housed in what was once the Davenport College for Women; and

Whereas, the facility was constructed in 1858 and used by the college until 1933; and

Whereas, funds are needed to maintain and repair the facility; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Caldwell County Historical Society, Incorporated, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year for maintenance and repairs of the Caldwell County Heritage Museum's facility and for historical displays.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
