A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR REPAIRS TO THE HISTORIC GILL HOUSE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Scotland County for the Scotland County Historical Properties Commission the sum of fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year for repairs to the historic Gill House. The house was the residence of former State Treasurer, Edwin Gill. The house is currently owned by the Scotland County Historical Properties Commission.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
