A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
AND CONSUMER SERVICES FOR THE CAPITAL COSTS OF ESTABLISHING
A FARMERS' MARKET IN WILMINGTON.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for the Castle Street Association, Inc., for the capital costs of establishing a local farmers' market in Wilmington to provide agricultural services and to encourage the participation of the business and agricultural communities in economic development.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
