A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL RESOURCES FOR TRYON PALACE HISTORIC SITES AND GARDENS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of five million one hundred twenty-one thousand eight hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$5,121,888) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year for Tryon Palace Historic Sites and Gardens. The funds shall be used to accomplish site evaluation for the Barbour Boat Works project, including environmental assessment, compliance archaeology, compliance with regulatory agencies to acquire necessary permits and site cleanup, and demolition of structures at the site.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
