A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INITIATE THE DEVELOPMENT OF A
PERMANENT COLLABORATIVE DELIVERY SYSTEM OF HIGHER
EDUCATION IN EASTERN NORTH CAROLINA.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Community Colleges the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to initiate the development of a permanent collaborative delivery system of higher education between East Carolina University and Craven Community College in Eastern North Carolina. These funds shall be used to support the design of the programmatic aspects of the system and to plan a shared-use permanent facility allowing the university partner to have a dedicated presence on the campus of the community college.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
