1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO MODIFY THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP
3 ON THE STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND FOR
4 MEMBERSHIP ON THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF
5 NORTH CAROLINA.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 115D-2.1(d) reads as rewritten:

8 "(d) No member of the General Assembly, ~~no officer or employee of the State, and no~~
9 ~~officer or employee of the Department of Community Colleges, no person who within the~~
10 ~~prior five years has been an officer or employee of the Department of Community~~
11 ~~Colleges, no officer or employee of an institution under the jurisdiction of the State Board~~
12 ~~Board, and no spouse of any of those persons, shall be eligible to serve on the State~~
13 ~~Board. Furthermore, no person who within the prior five years has been an employee of the~~
14 ~~Department of Community Colleges shall be eligible to serve on the State Board."~~

15 Section 2. G.S. 116-7(b) reads as rewritten:

16 "(b) From and after July 1, 1973, no member of the General Assembly or officer or
17 employee ~~of the State or of any constituent institution or spouse of any such member,~~
18 officer or employee may be a member of the Board of Governors. Any member of the

1 Board of Governors who is elected or appointed to the General Assembly or who
2 becomes an officer or employee ~~of the State or~~ of any constituent institution or whose
3 spouse is elected or appointed to the General Assembly or becomes such officer or
4 employee shall be deemed thereupon to resign from his membership on the Board of
5 Governors."

6 Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999, and applies to elections
7 and appointments occurring after that date.
