A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP  
ON THE STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND FOR  
MEMBERSHIP ON THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF  
NORTH CAROLINA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 115D-2.1(d), as amended by S.L. 1999-84, reads as rewritten:

"(d) No member of the General Assembly, ~~no officer or employee of the State, and no officer or employee of the Community Colleges System Office, no person who within the prior five years has been an officer or employee of the Department of Community Colleges,~~ no officer or employee of an institution under the jurisdiction of the State ~~Board~~ Board, and no spouse of any of those persons, shall be eligible to serve on the State Board. ~~Furthermore, no person who within the prior five years has been an employee of the Community Colleges System Office shall be eligible to serve on the State Board.~~"

Section 2. G.S. 116-7(b) reads as rewritten:

1       "(b) From and after July 1, 1973, no member of the General Assembly or officer or  
2 employee ~~of the State or~~ of any constituent institution or spouse of any such member,  
3 officer or employee may be a member of the Board of Governors. Any member of the  
4 Board of Governors who is elected or appointed to the General Assembly or who  
5 becomes an officer or employee ~~of the State or~~ of any constituent institution or whose  
6 spouse is elected or appointed to the General Assembly or becomes such officer or  
7 employee shall be deemed thereupon to resign from his membership on the Board of  
8 Governors."

9               Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999, and applies to elections  
10 and appointments occurring after that date.
